He was providing music for the machines as needed. Ray retired from the roll business about 20+ years ago but to this day, you can visit collections all around the world and find his box labels, "Siou's Music". He definitely deserves a place in history for his music roll service. If not for Ray's early efforts we would not have the extensive choice of music he provided.
