(2) Awards

An awards committee consisting of Dave Saul, Richard Tonnesen and I considered nominations for the AMICA International Award and the Leo Ornstein Literary Award. The committee's recommendations are as follows:

International Award

The AMICA International Award will be awarded to Kenneth K. Caswell of Austin, Texas. Ken recently retired after 17 years as manager of the Austin Symphony, is widely known and respected for his knowledge of the Welte reproducing systems and piano rolls.

Ken had a long-time dream to accurately record and preserve the rare composer-played music embodied on reproducing piano rolls. After 40 years of study and research, Ken produced seven historic classical piano CDs recorded on the Pierian label. The Pierian Recording Society is a tax-exempt organization whose purpose is the preservation of historic performances and obscure repertoire.
